Policy X Oath of Office

- 1. An oath of office must be signed by all councillors of the SRC.
 - 1.1. Members elected to Executive positions within the MSVUSU shall take this oath during training or at their first Executive Meeting in their role;
 - 1.2. Members elected to the SRC shall take this oath during their respective training, or at their first SRC meeting as an elected member.
- The Oath shall take the form of a written declaration with the following wording:
 "I. having been (elected/appointed) an (Officer and/or
 - "I,_____, having been (elected/appointed) an (Officer and/or Director) of the Mount Saint Vincent University Students' Union, do solemnly declare that for my term of office I shall abide by and uphold the Constitution, By-Laws and Policies of the MSVUSU. I will fulfill the duties
 - of my office, while maintaining and upholding the dignity of the MSVUSU. I further understand that failure to comply with this declaration may be grounds for removal under Article 4.3 of the MSVUSU Constitution."
 - 2.1. All SRC members will be required to read the declaration carefully and indicate their acceptance of its terms by affixing their signature and dating the document.
 - 2.2. The President shall maintain originals of each "Oath of Office" declaration in a secure location until the completion of the term of the SRC member. After that time all original declarations shall be considered void and shall be destroyed.
