Policy II Transition for the Students' Representative Council (SRC)

- As the governing body of the MSVUSU it is important as an organization to provide SRC members with professional development and background information about the MSVUSU
- 2. Following the General Elections newly elected councilors and executive shall be required to attend at least one meeting of the SRC prior to taking office.
- 3. Following their election, the incoming and outgoing SRC councilors shall be required to hold at least one (1) transitioning meeting. This meeting shall cover but is not limited to;
 - 3.1. Work done over the year and any ongoing work that needs to be completed
 - 3.2. Discussion relationship that have been built over the course of holding the position
 - 3.3. Any committee assignments
- 4. A Fall training session shall be held with the entire SRC following the Fall By-Election.
 - 4.1. This session shall be mandatory and planned by the Speaker with assistance from the President and the Recording Secretary. The training session shall include:
 - 4.1.1. Education on Roberts Rules of Order;
 - 4.1.2. Education on the MSVUSU Constitution, By-Laws and Policies
 - 4.1.3. Education on MSVUSU services, businesses and history;
 - 4.1.4. Committee membership is to be discussed and councilors appointed to appropriate committees;
 - 4.1.5. Councilors will be provided with an overview of the MSVUSU organizational structure;
 - 4.1.6. Developing teamwork;
 - 4.1.7. The importance of confidentiality will be discussed and councilors will be asked to sign the confidentiality agreement
 - 4.1.8. An anti-oppression training workshop will be facilitated during training;
