Executive Position Overview

President

Leads the student union, represents students, and oversees operations.

Requirements:

- Must be entering their third year of study or higher (6.2.1).
- Must have extensive experience working with and for the Students' Union or other relevant experience (6.2.1).

Vice-President Communications

Manages student engagement, social media, and external communications.

Requirements:

- Must be entering their third year of study or higher (6.2.2).

Vice-President Student Life

Plans student events, campus activities, and community-building initiatives.

Requirements:

- Must be entering their third year of study or higher (6.2.4).

Vice-President Advocacy & Undergraduate Affairs

Represents student concerns, works on policy changes, and supports student rights.

Requirements:

- Must be entering their third year of study or higher (6.2.3).

Vice-President Research & Graduate Affairs

Represents graduate students, promotes research opportunities, and supports academic policies.

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in a graduate studies program (6.2.5).

Representative Position Overview

Accessibility Representative

Ensures accessibility needs are met and advocates for an inclusive campus.

Requirements:

- Must identify as living with accessibility needs (6.2.7).

2SLGBTQIA+ Representative

Supports and advocates for students within the 2SLGBTQIA+ community.

Requirements:

- Must identify as part of the 2SLGBTQIA+ community (6.2.6).

Board of Governors Representative

Represents student interests at the Board of Governors meetings.

Requirements:

- Any MSVUSU member may run (6.2.10).

Gender Advocacy Representative

Advocates for gender equity and supports policies for gender diversity.

Requirements:

- Must self-identify as a person with an equity-denied gender (6.2.20).

Indigenous Representative

Advocates for Indigenous students and promotes cultural awareness.

Requirements:

- Must identify as Indigenous (6.2.13).

International Student Representative

Supports international students and addresses unique challenges such as visas and housing.

Requirements:

- Must be an international student (not a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant) (6.2.14).

Representative Position Overview Cont'd

Mature Student Representative

Advocates for mature students balancing academics with other responsibilities.

Requirements:

- Must be 25 years or older (6.2.15).

BIPOC Representative

Represents and supports Black, Indigenous, and People of Colour (BIPOC) students.

Requirements:

- Must identify as BIPOC (6.2.9).

Residence Representative

Acts as the voice of students living in residence and addresses housing concerns.

Requirements:

- Must be living in residence during their term (6.2.17).

Transfer Student Representative

Supports students who have transferred from other institutions and helps with the transition.

Requirements:

- Must have previously been enrolled at another post-secondary institution (6.2.19).

Science Representative

Represents students in the Faculty of Science and promotes STEM-related initiatives.

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in the Faculty of Science as per the most recent MSVU Academic Calendar (6.2.18).

Arts Representative

Advocates for arts students and supports creative opportunities on campus.

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in the Faculty of Arts as per the most recent MSVU Academic Calendar (6.2.8).

Representative Position Overview Cont'd

Education Representative

Supports and advocates for students enrolled in the Faculty of Education.

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in the Faculty of Education as per the most recent MSVU Academic Calendar (6.2.11).

Professional Studies Representative

Advocates for students in the Faculty of Professional Studies and supports professional development.

Requirements:

- Must be enrolled in the Faculty of Professional Studies as per the most recent MSVU Academic Calendar (6.2.16).
